This course provides law enforcement officers with the essential elements of evaluating, planning, and conducting an executive protection operation. Emphasis is placed on proactive approaches to each element, including theory, functionality, locality, and team composition.

Participants will learn concepts which include: route analysis, motorcade operations and foot formations, firearms fundamentals while protecting a principal and advance operational planning to include scheduled routes, arrival/departures to and from visit sites, and high and low-profile operations. The course includes analysis of attack case studies and practical exercises covering all key aspects of executive protection operations.

Course techniques and methods have been taught to members of local, state and federal law enforcement agencies. Instructors for the practical exercises include personal protection specialist (PPS) agents and a protective detail leader.

Prerequisites: Must be a certified law enforcement officer able to provide current credentials upon request.
