This highly interactive 8-hour course provides participants with a comprehensive, blended learning experience focusing on Constitutional concepts related to the 4th Amendment of the United States Constitution and Virginia-specific law. Course participants explore the limitations and framework of the 4th Amendment utilizing up-to-date case law from the United States Supreme Court, 4th Federal Circuit Court of Appeals, the Virginia Supreme Court, and the Virginia Court of Appeals, ensuring participants receive the most current legal opinions.

Participants learn and understand the procedures and legal principles they must follow from the initial police/citizen encounter to various seizures and searches, and how the professionalism and credibility of officers and agencies will be scrutinized and challenged where cases are lost due to a technical failure by officers to follow the ever-changing legal principles, impacting public confidence and trust in law enforcement and directly impacting public safety.
